

Rules for registration of second-cycle full-time students in the academic year 2023/2024:

- Full registration requirements for students of the first year of studies cover the requirement to pass all compulsory and elective courses and the requirement to obtain 60 ECTS credits determined in the study programme for all preceding study stages.
- Minimum registration requirements for students of the first year of studies cover the requirement to obtain 48 ECTS credits.
- Students of the third semester of studies are required to submit a master thesis within the deadline specified in § 30.1 of the Academic Regulations at the Warsaw University of Technology.
- The Dean may postpone the date of diploma thesis submission at the student's request for no more than three months in relation to the dates specified in § 30.1 of the Academic Regulations at the Warsaw University of Technology. Applications for extending the deadline for submitting diploma thesis should be appraised by the diploma supervisor and submitted on time specified in § 30.1 of the Academic Regulations.
- Applications for extending the deadline for submitting a diploma thesis may be submitted by students who have completed all subjects covered by the study plan, excluding the diploma thesis.
- A prerequisite for receiving registration for the next semester of study is settlement of fees due to the University.
- Repeated registration for the same year of study may be obtained at the request of students of the first and second year, if it does not extend the studies for more than a year beyond their nominal duration.
- The Dean has the right to mitigate the registration requirements in individual justified cases.
